

## ATHE Level 6 Diploma in Management

### Entry Requirements

These qualifications are designed for learners who are typically aged 19 and above. ATHE's policy regarding access to our qualifications is that:

- they should be available to everyone who is capable of reaching the required standards
- they should be free from any barriers that restrict access and progression
- there should be equal opportunities for all those wishing to access the qualifications.

Community Revival will review the prior qualifications and experience of each learner and consider whether they provide the necessary foundations to undertake the programme of study at level 6. For learners with disabilities and specific needs, this review will take account of the support available to the learner during teaching and assessment of the qualification.

For learners who have recently been in education or training the entry profile is likely to include:

- one or two years study of Business, Management or related qualifications at a Higher Education Institution
- a level 5 qualification in Business, Management or related subjects for example an ATHE Level 5 Diploma in Management (QCF)
- other equivalent international qualifications.

Learners must also have an appropriate standard of English to enable them to access relevant resources and complete the unit assignments. Learners may also have relevant work experience. Mature learners may present a more varied profile of achievement that is likely to include relevant work experience (paid and/or unpaid) with levels of responsibility, participation and/or achievement of relevant professional qualifications. This may be used for recognition of prior learning (RPL).

Please note that UK Visas and Immigration Department (UKVI) requires adult students to have acceptable English language ability before they can apply to become an adult student under Tier 4 (General) of the points-based system. Community Revival will ensure that each applicant is competent in the English language at a minimum of CEFR level B2 for a QCF qualification at level 6 or above.

**The ATHE Level 6 Diploma in Management** is a 120 credit size qualification and is the equivalent level to the 3rd year of a degree.

This qualification combines six mandatory units totalling 75 credits including Leadership and Management, Human Resource Management and Strategic Marketing; and a further 3 or 4 optional units totalling 120 credits to achieve the ATHE Level 6 Diploma in Management.

## Course Content

Learners must complete 6 mandatory units and a further 3 or 4 optional units to achieve this qualification.
