

## ESOL Speaking & Listening Entry 1 to Level 2

### Entry Requirements

### Aim

To improve everyday English language skills in speaking and listening.

### Course Content

ESOL Skills for Life is for anyone based in the UK for whom English is a second or additional language.

These qualifications focus on the language used in everyday situations, helping learners into work or function more effectively in an English-speaking environment.

This unit concentrates on the **Speaking and Listening** elements of the language but many learners also study the other units in this programme (Reading and Writing) at the same time.

### Assessment

End-of-course externally-set examination
